Safety Tips for Driving in Fog

- Slow down before you enter fog. Do not assume that the fog will thin out after you enter it.
- Turn on your lights. Use low-beam headlights for best visibility even in daytime.
- Listen for traffic you cannot see.
- Be alert for other drivers who may have forgotten to turn on their lights.
- Turn on your 4-way flashers to let vehicles know when you are stopping at bus stops.
- Refrain from passing other vehicles.
- Watch for vehicles that have pulled off to the side of the road, and be aware that seeing taillights in front of you might not be an accurate indication that the vehicles are on the roadway.
